

## The beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary Year

Having been formed in 1997, 2016 marked the beginning of the year leading to the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Confraternity in June 2017. HE the Grand Master Peter Paul Portelli, and the Grand Chancellor and his Personal Secretary Chev Joseph Coleiro commenced planning for the Convention of the Confraternity to take place in Nadur, Gożo, Malta in late June (23<sup>rd</sup> -30<sup>th</sup> see below) 2017.

As part of those preparations, travelling to Malta in September 2016, Chev. Coleiro met with members of the Confraternity including Chev. Eddie Vella, the Grand Prior for Malta, and visited key sites to be visited by members of the Confraternity attending the Convention in 2017.



These included the Grand Hotel, then planned as a venue for parts of the Convention and the basilica in Nadur, and met with some aspirants.

#### 2016 - The new Neck Medal

After considerable work and research, including into the colour of the ribbon, carried out by H.E. the Grand Master Peter Portelli, and the Grand Chancellor Chev Joseph Coleiro, the design for the new neck medal that had started in 2015, was finalized. Following a global search, a manufacturer was selected. One candidate company for the manufacture of the medal, who is a long-experienced maker of the official State medals issued by the government, described the medal as the most intricate and challenging medal in his experience. The medal production started in, and it was launched in 2016.

#### 2016 – The Grand Master new neck chain

As part of changes to the regalia worn by members, the decision was made that the Grand Master should wear a chain of office. This is a personalized chain.

The design includes the neck medal with a chain having



alternate shields one bearing the crest of the Confraternity and one being quartered with the Confraternity Cross and the Maltese family name crest for Portelli – being the crest of H.E. the Grand Master Peter Paul Portelli.

## 2016 – Changes to tunic for Grand Chancellor

In 2016, H.E. the Grand Master decided to change the tunic of the Grand Chancellor and set out with Archgrand Prior Dame Angela Greto (the seamstress who attends to all the robes in Australia) to design and issue a one to the Grand Chancellor and his Personal Secretary who was also elevated to Knight Commander of Justice, in advance of the 2017 Malta Congress. 


# 2016 – September fundraising for earthquake appeal

This is the spirit of giving and support of the Confraternity.





### Grand Council, Melbourne, Australia

In short, there was much planning and preparation for the conference in Malta for June 2017, spearheaded by the Grand Master H.E. Peter Paul Portelli. All Council members were most active in the planning, with the groundwork having been set by H.E. the Grand Master in previous years and visits to the Islands, and the visit by the Grand Chancellor Chev Joseph Coleiro to the islands in 2016 for that purpose.

On arrival in Malta in early June 2017, ahead of the conference and with time to attend to last minute planning and administrative matters on site, H.E. the Grand Master and the Grand Chancellor spent many hours and days in meetings reviewing the draft book on the History of the Confraternity, attending to updates and formatting for printing. ## January 2021 - New Chapter in Puerto Rico

After review and research, and deliberation, the Supreme Council of the Confraternity accepted a request by Mitered Archimandrite His Excellency The Rt. Revd. Dr. Andrew Vujisic to open a chapter in San Juan, Puerto Rico.

This is the first chapter run by a church. It is in the Archdiocese of Puerto Rico, centered in the capital of that nation, San Juan. It will be centred at the Church of St Spyridon:

## His Excellency Archbishop Roberto Gonzalez Nieves - Archbishop of San Juan

HE Archbishop Roberto González Nieves is the *Metropolitan Archbishop* at the head of the Roman Catholic Church in Puerto Rico. Metropolitan Archbishop or '*Metropolitan*', in the Roman Catholic, Eastern Orthodox, and Anglican churches, is the head of an ecclesiastical province, originally resided in the chief city, or metropolis, of the province. The first known use of the title was at the Council of Nicaea in 325.

On March 26, 1999, Pope John Paul II appointed His Excellency Archbishop Roberto González Nieves as Archbishop of San Juan, Puerto Rico. Prior to then, HE Archbishop Nieves had served in United States diocese, particularly in New York and Boston. HE Archbishop Roberto González Nieves was installed as Archbishop on May 8 1999.

The candidates Jean Paul Portelli, James Buttigieg and Matthias Mercieca took the vow of knights.



## Registration of the Logo

Beginning in 2019, and culminating in 2020, H.E. the Grand Master Peter Paul Portelli and his Personal Secretary and Grand Chancellor, Chev Joseph Coleiro KCJ CKSPSP attended to all the steps to make a reality the registration internationally of the Confraternity Logo, being the Crest of the Confraternity and its Flag design.

This step provides protection for the crest and flag which were designed after much deliberation by H.E. the Grand Master Peter Portelli, the Grand Chancellor Chev Joseph Coleiro, and the Arch Grand Prior Dame Angela Greto in consultation with the Supreme Council with input on the artwork also by various gifted members of the Confraternity.

The grant of that protection was conformed in 2020:


The flag of the Confraternity of the Knights of St. Peter & St. Paul is now a registered Trade mark.

The flag colours are red and yellow, being the colours of Nadur, Gożo which parish is the birthpace of the founde H.E. Grand Master Peter Portelli, and is dedicated to St Peter and St Paul. Central to the flag is the crest of the Confraternity being:

- a Maltese Cross reflecting the roots of the Confraternity in the Islands of Malta
- the colour of the cross is black, distinguishing it from the red, white and green used by various Orders of St John
- a prince's crown in red

- St Peter and St Paul badge of the Confraternity at its center
- yellow ribbon reflecting one of the colours of the flag, and red being in the Crown

The flag and the crest of the Confraternity can only be used with the written permission of the Confraternity through the Supreme Council represented by H.E. the Grand Master sealed with the official seal of the Confraternity, applied in accordance with its Rules.



### 2021

### 550<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

2021 is the 550<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first knights of St. Peter, established by Pope Paul II in 1471.

### Pope Paul II

In 1471 Pope Paul II conferred the first investitures of "Knights of St. Peter" or "Cavaliere di San Pietro", which was an honorific title conferred by the Holy See. This honorary chivalrous investiture from the Holy See is sometimes called the "Speron d'Oro", quite distinct from the Cavalry Knighthoods conferred by various Sovereigns.

#### Pope Leo 10

By the time of Pope Leo 10, the Order of the Knights of St. Peter's was made up of 401 men chosen from among the best and most faithful collaborators of the Pope and of the Church.

The Order was given the task of managing the administrative affairs of the Apostolic Camera, and to ensure a body of knights to defend the safety of the person of the Pope and of the same hospitals used on various sectors of necessity of war.

### Pope Clement VII

Pope Clement VII was born Giulio de 'Medici. He was the successor of Pope Leo X in 1522.

He confirmed this Order with a further Bull issued in October of 1526, published at the Chancery of the Pontifical January 3, 1527.

### Pope Paul III

Pope Paul III who succeeded Pope Clement VII reaffirmed the Board of the Knights of St. Peter (Papal Bull of 26 February 1534, published in the Papal Chancellery on 20 December 1535) with the same forms, methods and content produced by Pope Leo X.

Pope Paul III however, most wanted to not duplicate such an order, creating another mirror under the name of the College of the Knights of St. Paul, by a Bull of 25 June 1540, which saw the publication in the Papal Chancellery July 19, 1541.

### **Treaties**

The year saw the formation of treaties of friendship and mutual recognition for charitable work. The first was with the OSHMT:

### OSHMT - Ordo Supremus Militaris Templi Hierosolymitani - Knights Templar

January 2021 saw an invitation from the Order of the Knights Templar - OSHMT "Ordo Supremus Militaris Templi Hierosolymitani", from the Grand Chancellor Cav. Marco Pirillo inviting the Confraternity to join in establishing a friendly relationship between the Order and the Confraternity.

The Supreme Council voted in favour of pursuing and entering this most historical step with OSHMT.


