The Noble Family of the Grand Master

The Falzon family are direct descendants of the Falson/Falzon family which traces back its origins to the 13th century. The Noble family of Falzon moved possibly from Sicily or Spain to Malta and settled in Citta Notabile in Mdina. Federico De Falcone, Baron de Burgio, of the Princely House of Paterno', Augusta Sicilia Italia, born: 1257 died: Dec 6 1286 Messina Sicilia Italia. This was during the reign of **King Martin I and Queen Maria of Sicily and Malta**.

Almost exactly a century later, on 19th July 1399, Antonio Falsone, a citizen of Malta, obtained the grant of Djar il-Chandul, a tenimentum (holding) of thirteen salmas, from King Martin in reward for having greatly assisted in the recovery of the Maltese Islands to his rule, but for which Antonio was expected to pay an annual census of six golden uncie.

On 15th October 1457 Notary Antonio de Falsone was granted a stretch of land at II-Fiddien described in the grant not to exceed six tuminatas in amount, subject to the annual payment of one tareno per tuminata. The Falzons owned a large amount of land and kept several slaves up till mid 1800. It is recorded that Domenico Falzon was born on February 26th, 1636 and was baptised at the Matrice in Gozo, before Nadur became a parish and died on January 19th 1706 in Nadur. The history of the Falzons is long and many of the family members held high posts such as notaries, judges and some, where elected Capitano della Verga, a position similar to a limited governorship. My great grandfather Pietro Falzon married Margherita Xuereb. His son Michele Falzon married Maria Attard. Their daughter Margerita Falzon married Coronato Portelli. Their Son Baron Chevalier Peter Paul Portelli Falzon – Grand Master of the Confraternity of the Knights of St. Peter & St. Paul.

The Grand Chapter of Malta based in Nadur, Gozo, is organizing a BBQ for the Members and their families to meet and chat together.


The BBQ is being held on Tuesday 8 August, 2023 at Hondoq Bay, in Qala.

Fr Karm Attard, a Salesian from Nadur who spent 72 years working among the missions in India, died in India on November 19 aged 94. He had originally gone to Bombay in December 1933 at the age of 22 and his first missionary work was in a village near Himalayan Mountains.




He succeeded in setting up seven parishes with churches, a number of schools and orphanages in Marbisu, Mairang, Nongstoin, Sonapahar, Rangblang, Mawkyrwat and Nongkwar, with the assistance of Maltese and Gozitan benefactors.

In June 2002, he was granted the award Gieh in-Nadur.
