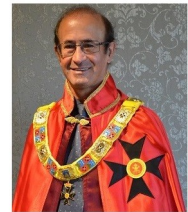

God bless all You.

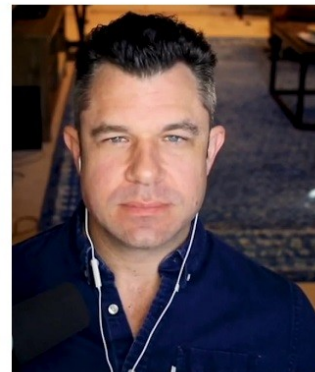

I would like to ask if we can send a formal request for assistance for some elderly in our parish who are poor and have indecent houses. For instance we have Augustine Mwayipopo; he is old, blind, has difficulties in walking, and suffers from pneumonia and cough because he lives in an indecent house as you can see the attached pictures.

The house has no doors, no windows, it has a dusty floor. As a parish we would like to reach out to these people by renovating their houses.

St Steven's Parish is one of the parishes in the Diocese of Karonga. The Diocese of Karonga is found in Northern Malawi. Malawi is a landlocked country in south-eastern Africa. Occupying a narrow, curving strip of land along the East African Rift Valley, it is bordered by Zambia to the northwest, Tanzania to the northeast and Mozambique to the south, southwest and southeast. It is one of the poorest countries in the world.
