Grand Master's Message

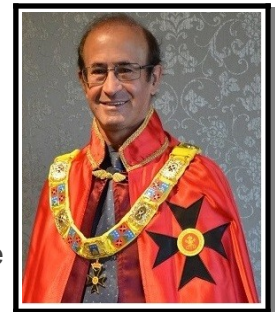
Dear Confrères and Friends of the Confraternity,
